Reminders: absence and school car park

Parents/carers are expected to phone the school absence line (01275 850400) on each day that their child is absent, stating the reason(s) for the absence. Mrs Coles is our Attendance Officer.

In relation to sickness the expected protocol is that if a child is sick before noon on any given day, they must stay off at least 1 more full day. If the incident of sickness is after noon on any given day, they must stay off an additional 2 days.

Please also remember that parents should only be driving into the school car park to drop off students in <u>exceptional circumstances</u>. If there is a medical/physical reason for this need please contact the Heads of House where this can be noted. We do have students who have agreed permission to drop at the front of the school. There are school coaches and buses that drop students off in the morning and the increased traffic flow from parents dropping students in their cars does cause an issue.

Thank you for ensuring that the safety of our students continues to be our prime focus.
