Nailsea School – Covid-19 Information

Since school returned after half-term we have received enquiries from parents in regards to what actions it is taking over any outbreak of Covid-19 (Coronavirus).

The school is following advice given by Public Health England, the Department for Education and North Somerset Council. We are also monitoring the absence reasons of any staff or students that we are aware of who may have been in or near any affected areas over the half-term break including those that were on a school ski trip.
