












Safe Return to School Pledge

Nailsea School pledges to our families:

1		We have followed and implemented a risk assessment framework with the safety of staff and students being a priority. This follows official guidance and will be updated as the guidance evolves.
2		With social distancing measures in mind we have reorganised the layout of the school, including introducing one-way systems and reducing class sizes, which will be no bigger than 15 students.
3		To secure the integrity of the site we have reduced footfall around the building by having staggered start/leaving times, static classrooms with students being allocated specific desks and ensuring resources are not shared.
4		We have increased stocks of equipment to ensure that hygiene is paramount – including soaps and gels which are available in classrooms and public areas, as well as in toilet areas. Increased deep cleaning has been in place since March and will continue, daily.
5		All staff will follow social distancing and hygiene guidelines. Posters have been positioned around the school site reminding everyone of these expectations.
6		We will continue to stay in touch with all of our families through regular letters, phone calls, social media updates and the website. We do want to hear from you as well. Please contact us if you have any questions or queries.
7		We will try our best to accommodate individual preferences where possible e.g the choice of wearing face masks.
8		For those students that are not yet returning to school we will continue to provide work and feedback to them so their home learning can continue.
