

RSE Policy: Consultation Dear parents/carers,

In light of upcoming changes to requirements for relationships and sex education (RSE) and health education, we have been consulting with parents, pupils and staff on how we can make sure that our updated RSE curriculum meets the new requirements as well as the needs of our pupils. As in previous years, the RSE curriculum will be delivered through the ABSolute curriculum extended tutor time and aspects of the requirements will feature in curriculum subjects across the school such as Science or RE.

We have worked hard to make sure that our new curriculum reflects:

- Our pupils' age and maturity levels, as well as their cultural and religious backgrounds
- The values of our Nailsea school community
- Our core values of aspire, believe, succeed and #teamnailsea
- Every pupil's learning needs
- What pupils need to know to be healthy and safe in school, in their personal relationships and in the wider world

We have now updated our RSE policy to include our proposed new curriculum.
