- ★ Demonstrates in written work the ability to analyse and sustain logical chains of reasoning
- ★ Demonstrates the ability to evaluate from the beginning and throughout essays, coming to a well supported and academically convincing conclusion
- ★ Demonstrates an enthusiasm for and desire to study the subject beyond the parameters of the syllabus.

- ★ Give opportunities for students to debate the issues with pertinent and challenging questions so that students demonstrate they able to think critically
