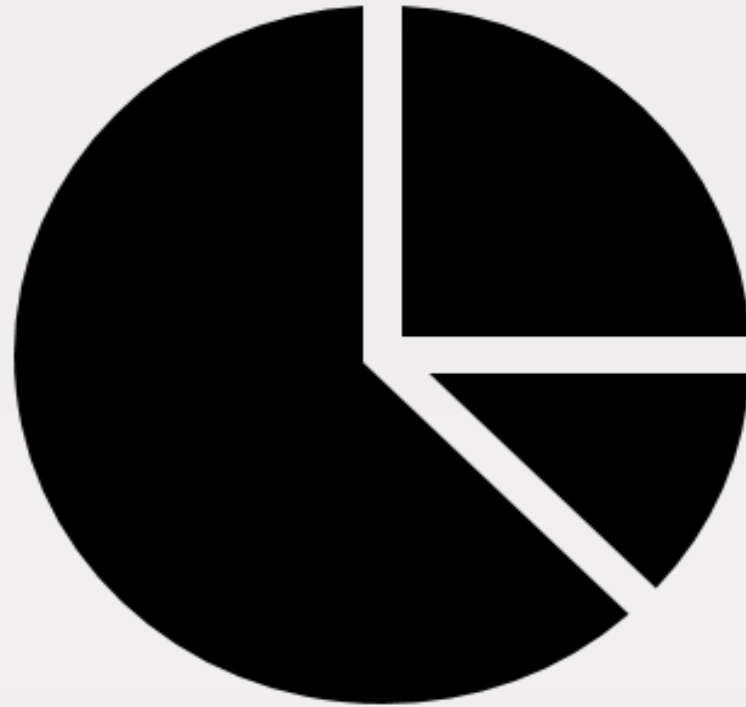


Component 3 – External Assessment. Sit Exam – May of Year 11
