Aim Higher Task:

Creating a campaign for change



Your first unit in Criminology requires you to plan a campaign for change. You will need to be able to plan a campaign to raise awareness of an under reported crime and you will be asked to design materials to promote that campaign. Therefore the aim of this task is to give you a chance to practice planning a campaign.

Task: Hate crime is an example of a crime that often goes under reported. You are going to create materials that you could use in a campaign against hate crime. By the end you should have a document (either word, PPT or hand written) with all the following tasks completed.

STEP 1. Background information.

Using the internet carry out the following tasks and write/type your findings.

- 1. Find some statistics relating to hate crime. (This could be focused on disability, race, gender, sexuality etc.)
- 2. Find out how people can report hate crimes.

STEP 2: Planning your campaign for change

- What is your campaign going to be called?
- What is the slogan for your campaign?
- What are your objectives/aims i.e. what do you want to achieve (no more than three)?


STEP 3: Campaign methods - promotion of action

For this part of the activity you are going to design resources that will help you to promote your campaign, these might be:

- Merchandise tshirt/water bottle etc. (There are lots of websites you can use to design items, make sure you do not accidently buy anything! Take a snip of the page and copy and paste in image.)
- Poster / Leaflets (can you PPT or internet software like Canva)
- Social media posts <u>https://zeoob.com/generate-twitter-tweet/</u>
- Short video/TV advertisement
- Plan an event (describe how you would go about it)
