I know that enrichment week is a part of school life that many parents and students have regularly asked about being reinstated and I am very excited that this will return to the school calendar next year.

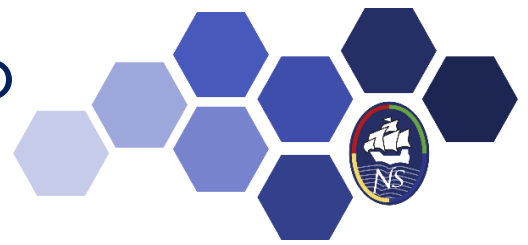

Mill on the Brue Residential - £305

Wednesday 26th- Friday 28th June

An Outdoor Activity Centre residential involving around 8 activities which could include assault course, canoeing, climbing, crossing the river, toboggan, high ropes, orienteering, raft building and other river activities. Exact activities are yet to be confirmed and could vary slightly from those mentioned.

Kilve Court Residential - £225

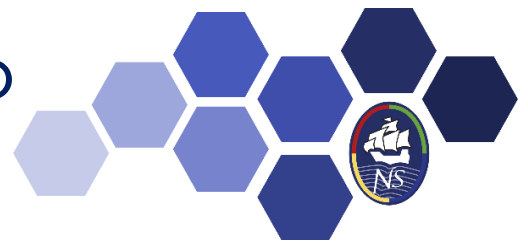
Wednesday 26th-Friday 28th June

Kilve Court is an Outdoor Activity Centre situated in the Quantock Hills. The two day trip will be packed with a variety of land and water activities such as: Abseiling, Archery, Mountain biking, Buggy building, Climbing, Kayaking, Paddle boarding and more team building and adventure activities (To be confirmed). Once the busy day of activities is complete, students will get the chance to eat and socialise together, as well as choice of some game sports or taking part in a night walk to listen to the night's sounds and wonder at the stars.

Music tour to Belgium - £550-£650

Date - likely travel dates - 24th to 27th of June 2024 (+/- a day). Will be 4 days and 3 nights.

A fantastic opportunity to visit the city of Antwerp in Belgium and take part in concerts as well as exploring the local area. Students on the trip will play an instrument or sing in a group and learn pieces they will perform in bandstands, market squares, concert halls and more. As well as lots of music, the trip will include exciting excursions such as visiting a chocolate factory, a riverboat cruise, bowling, a local theme park and other attractions. Music tours are fun, creative and a great chance to spend time with other students who love music - in the past many have said tour was one of their most memorable experiences at school, and that they made friends for life! Students keen to sign up for music tour don't need previous experience - they may have been playing their instrument or singing for a while, or may be starting something new. Students should be willing to attend lunchtime tour rehearsals before the trip. Students eligible for this trip are those in years 7-9 and Year 11. Students must be keen to perform in a band or choir, and be willing to attend lunchtime rehearsals before the trip.
