



Dear Parent/Carer,

Following the cancellation of the trip to Tyntesfield on Thursday 25th June due to the Red Weather Warning, we are delighted to inform you that we have re-arranged for the Creative Entrepreneurs trip to go ahead on Friday 26th instead. We have made some slight changes to the plan for the day, to allow us time to create our marketing project back at school and to avoid being in the sun during the hottest part of the day.

Students will take part in a range of activities including building a Film and TV Trail, team challenges, a photography challenge, and activities focused on bringing inspiration from Tyntesfield back to Nailsea School. There will also be opportunities for students to enjoy the grounds, spend time in nature, and explore the estate responsibly with their peers.

As we will be outdoors for the majority of the day, students should attend in non-school uniform suitable for outdoor activities and the hot weather conditions. Please ensure all students have:

We will be leaving school at approximately 9:45am and will return to school at 1:30pm after which we will be working on our marketing project until 3pm.
