Dear Parent/Carer

We are delighted to be taking students to Tyntesfield on Thursday 25th June as part of our Creative Entrepreneurs programme during IGNITE Week.

During the day, students will be working on a marketing project, where they will be collecting ideas, photos and images for their project. They will be working collaboratively and engaging creatively with the natural environment.

Students will take part in a range of activities including building a Film and TV Trail, team challenges, a photography challenge, and activities focused on bringing inspiration from Tyntesfield back to Nailsea School. There will also be opportunities for students to enjoy the grounds, spend time in nature, and explore the estate responsibly with their peers.

As we will be outdoors for the majority of the day, students should attend in non-school uniform suitable for outdoor activities and the weather conditions. We recommend comfortable footwear and clothing appropriate for walking and being outside for extended periods of time.

As there is limited shelter around the grounds, students should plan appropriately for all weather conditions.

This may include:

- A waterproof coat in case of rain
- Suncream
- A hat/cap
- Extra layers if cooler weather is expected

Students should bring:

- A small bag/backpack
- Pen
- Clipboard if they have one (please do not purchase one specifically — we can work around this if needed)
- Packed lunch
- Snacks
- Water bottle

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There will be a photography-based activity during the day. If students have access to a camera or mobile phone, they are welcome to bring it for this activity. However, this is a group task and students without a device will not be disadvantaged in any way.

Students may also bring a small amount of money should they wish to purchase food or snacks from the café.

We will be leaving school at approximately 9:30am and will return before the end of the school day at 3pm.
