Dear Parent/Carer,

I am really pleased that your child will be joining us at the Snow Dome, as part of the Peak Performance IGNITE week.

The **Snow Dome trip to Tamworth will be on Thursday 25th June 2026**. Please see important information and actions below.

Trip Details

- Location of Trip – Snow Dome, Tamworth, B79 7ND
- Itinerary:
 - Student arrival at Nailsea School – 6:15am
 - Coach leaving by 6:30am
 - Arrival at Tamworth Snow Dome – 9am
 - Ski Lesson – 10am-12pm
 - Lunch – 12-1pm
 - Ice Skating – 1pm-2pm
 - Leaving Tamworth Snow Dome – 2:30-3pm
 - Arrival back to Nailsea School to be picked up by parent/carer – 5:30pm
- Travel Arrangements – Students will travel by coach, accompanied by Nailsea School staff

Ability Range

There will be 5 groups of lessons taking place, with 12 students in each group. Students will be grouped according to their ability, rather than carrying out the lesson with their friends. There will be plenty of time throughout the trip for students to interact with their friends, and they will of course be skiing on the same slope, but it is important to ensure that students are in the correct ability group for their safety. Therefore, the groups will be created by Nailsea School staff and the Snow Dome, after careful consideration. These groups will be shared with students on the day of the trip.

On the permission form (see below), please accurately enter your child's skiing ability from the following options:

- Level 1 – complete beginner, without any skiing experience
- Level 2 – some basic skiing experience, such as a lesson on a dry slope
- Level 3 – skiing experience, having skied on snow before
- Level 4 – competent skier, having skied for a week or more
- Level 5 – confident skier, managing blue and red slopes

Ski Kit List

Please ensure that your child has the below kit list, to be able to ski:

- Gloves
- Long sleeve top and trousers
- Warm coat
- Layers under coat, such as T-shirt or thermal and jumper/hoodie
- Long, thick socks
- Waterproof trousers or salopettes (or at least thicker joggers with base layer)

Ski Equipment

The Snow Dome will provide your child with skis, boots and a helmet.

To ensure that your child is loaned the correct and safe skis, please provide the following information in the permission form (see below):

- Height – cm
- Weight – kg
- Shoe Size - UK

This information will be shared with the Snow Dome so that they can prepare the appropriate equipment.

All students will be required to wear a helmet throughout their time on the ski slope.

Additional Information

- Please ensure your child has all of their belongings in one bag, with all their belongings clearly named.
- Your child will need to bring a **packed lunch and drink**, as there will not be the opportunity to purchase food or drinks during our trip. Students should also bring snacks for the journey and throughout the day, if they wish.
- If your child is travel sick, please give your child any required travel medication before the trip, and any medication in a labelled envelope for their return journey – please indicate this on the permission form.
- Your child will be required to bring any medication that you list on the permission form, otherwise they may not be able to attend.
- A trained instructor will provide ski tuition and supervision throughout students' time on the slope, and Nailsea School staff will supervise students during their time on the ice-skating rink
