DAY BEFORE

Be prepared - before the day of the exam, students should:

- Have all of your **equipment ready**
- Know your **seat number**



EXAM BRIEFING

Be prompt for your exam briefings

- **8.30am** for morning exams
- **1.00pm** for afternoon exams



EXAM RULES

Water bottles and pencil cases need to be **clear** and **without labels**.

Mobile phones, air pods and watches **cannot be taken into the exam room** unless for medical / access purposes.



TOILET USE

There are **strict rules** regarding the use of toilet facilities during an exam, misuse could lead to a report of malpractice.

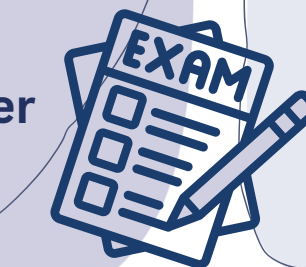
Unless it is a part of access arrangements students **should not** be using the toilet.
