



Lesson Routines

Being ready, respectful and responsible will make a difference for everyone.

Lessons are **1 hour long**.
Students need to be on time as
'every second counts'



If students are late they are marked with an 'L' mark (noting the minutes). This is monitored by their tutor and Head of House

Students sit in their designated seat and begin each lesson with a **'Do Now'** task.



This task helps recall important knowledge, so that students learn well over time.

Students will actively **participate in all tasks**, aiming high and asking for help when needed.

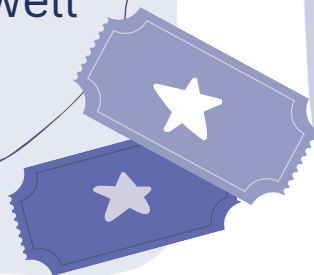


Taking pride in presentation demonstrates students are taking responsibility for their own learning.

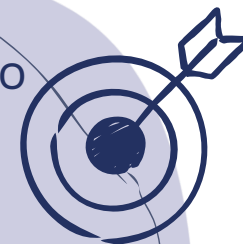
Staff will have greeted students and will present new material in small steps, supporting them to become more confident over time.



Staff will identify a **"Golden Ticket"** winner during every lesson, as well as issuing other house points



Students will not be permitted to disrupt teaching or learning.



Staff will **redirect** and **remind** students about expectations as needed

Refocus detentions (same day) will be issued to students. Behaviour resulting in a removal from the classroom will mean the student spends time in IR (**Internal Reflection**).

Students and staff are expected to remain in class for the hour.

There may be some exceptions:
· accompanied breaks
· medical card



Students **will not** be permitted to leave the lesson to refill water bottles or for toilet breaks – please use your breaktime to do this.
