Dear Parents/carers

RE: Move to Class Charts and away from SatchelOne/Show My Homework

I am delighted to inform you that over the next few weeks staff, students and parents will be moving to a new system; Class Charts. In the first instance this will be the way that students can access homework and, if required, any work during an extended period of absence from school if they are well enough to do so. The system runs on your phone or through a web browser and in the longer term parents will also be allocated a log in enabling them to see other key information – such as numbers of positive points, behaviour points, attendance and detentions issued. These will be issued in the next couple of weeks.

Homework will begin to be set for years 8 through to 13 in week commencing 20th September. Year 7 students will be following a different system of homework over the course of term one to aid with the transition into secondary school expectations. Details will follow in due course.

On Monday during tutor time student log in details will be issued to students. You can see an example of what to expect overleaf. If your son/daughter is not present in tutor time on Monday they should speak with their tutor who will be able to pass on the details when they are next in school.

Students have one week (week commencing 13th September) to use their log in and activate their account prior to homework starting to be set. If any student is having any issues please contact their tutor in the first instance. The sooner students activate their accounts the better. Students should use their Office 365 school email address to log in to Class Charts.

Class Charts is a user-friendly online system, which allows us to effectively monitor and report on homework, as well as upload resources. We strongly believe that this system will provide staff, parents and students with a much better experience. We are currently reviewing the online systems that we use as a school with a view to streamlining our services in the future. Currently the following are in place:

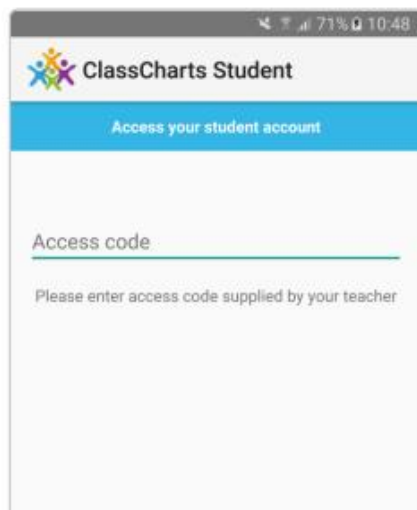

If your school has enabled the homework view, you will see a [Homework](#) option in the menu. Clicking on this displays a list of the homework you have been given.

Homework tasks fall under 3 different categories: [to do](#), [pending](#) and [submitted](#).

To do: These are the tasks that you need to complete. Once you have completed them, [tick the checkbox](#).

Pending: These are the tasks you have ticked as submitted, but have yet to be confirmed by your teacher.

Submitted: These tasks have been confirmed as completed by the teacher who gave you the homework.
