Come along to the library to play some board game favourites with your friends including a new Chess club area!




Chess Club

Lunchtime Film Club


This is a film club with a difference! We will watch films together and discuss how the storyline and plot reflects deeper philosophical and ethical questions.

Calling all young music enthusiasts! Join our Band Academy and jam with fellow talents. Rock the stage, make friends, and chase your rock star dreams.



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
Hockey

Just for fun! Everyone is welcome to this activity where students compete against each other and keep their fitness in check.






