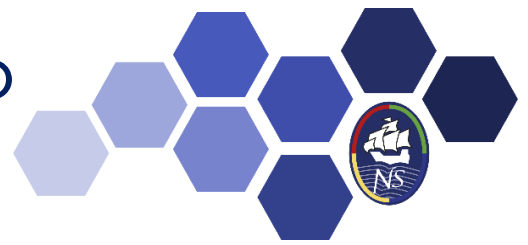
I know that enrichment week is a part of school life that many parents and students have regularly asked about being reinstated and I am very excited that this will return to the school calendar next year.

## Year 9 CEW Offsite Choices 2024

### **French language immersion residential - £520**

24th –28th June

French language immersion trip to northern France encompassing a variety of different activities such as French market trip, bakery demonstration, visit to Nausicaa sea life Centre and beach games... Ideal for those students wishing to practice their spoken French. Year 9 students studying French OR students considering studying French at GCSE (however taking GCSE French is not a condition of being able to attend this trip).

### **Battlefields trip - £455**

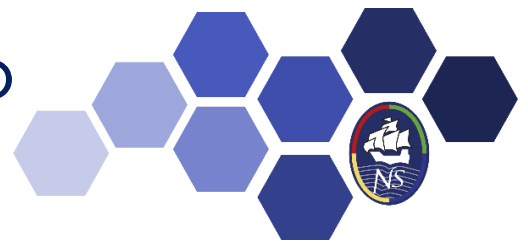
25th-28th June

The purpose of the visit is to allow students to uncover the major battles of World War I along with the profound impact this had on medical treatment at the time. This trip directly supports the GCSE course so students should only apply if they wish to take History at GCSE

### **Music tour to Belgium - £550-£650**

Date - likely travel dates - 24th to 27th of June 2024 (+/- a day). Will be 4 days and 3 nights.

A fantastic opportunity to visit the city of Antwerp in Belgium and take part in concerts as well as exploring the local area. Students on the trip will play an instrument or sing in a group and learn pieces they will perform in bandstands, market squares, concert halls and more. As well as lots of music, the trip will include exciting excursions such as visiting a chocolate factory, a riverboat cruise, bowling, a local theme park and other attractions. Music tours are fun, creative and a great chance to spend time with other students who love music - in the past many have said tour was one of their most memorable experiences at school, and that they made friends for life! Students keen to sign up for music tour don't need previous experience - they may have been playing their instrument or singing for a while, or may be starting something new. Students should be willing to attend lunchtime tour rehearsals before the trip. Students eligible for this trip are those in years 7-9 and Year 11. Students must be keen to perform in a band or choir, and be willing to attend lunchtime rehearsals before the trip.
