

Active Revision – Religious Studies

Assessment Point – Year 11 End of Year

Research shows that students who do frequent chunks of revision across all 3 stages of revision below are more likely to reach their full potential.

- ✓ Upload – consolidate your knowledge
- ✓ Process – active retrieval practice
- ✓ Download – apply your knowledge



TOPIC: *Christianity and Judaism*

- Create flashcards using your booklets and revision guide for each of the key words from all topics
- Create flashcards using your booklets and revision guide for each of the Bible verses
- Create an individual mind map summarising the key information for all topics
- Create an IFAC plan for all topics
- Re-read each topic and make brief notes
- Read model responses from the Revision Guide
- Read all 12 markers responses you've written in your booklet and look at your targets.
- Read the mark schemes for Paper 1 & 2 in the link below and make some notes.

- Memorise definitions for each of the Bible verses using the flashcards
- Memorise quotes for each of the Bible verses using the flashcard resources
- Use your memory and check it against the mind map you made in *Upload*.
- Use the IFAC structure in *Upload* to test yourself on the key arguments in each topic for a possible 12 marker
- Talk through the Bible quotes and explain to a friend why this is used in topics
- Add as many ideas as possible to your IFAC structure that you have may have missed off

- Plan practice questions as a mind map or outline.
- Write practice responses – either the entire response or one paragraph of a response as practice. *Use the IFAC structure.*
- Green pen previous responses in your exercise book to improve them.
