For each exam topic, you will use your booklet to create flashcards of the most important information you need to remember. This should include examples from the text using media terms.

*The purpose of the flash cards is to consolidate your knowledge of the Close Study Products.*



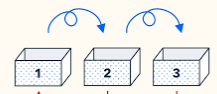

Your flashcards will be used to help you remember the key information – in lessons we will be using the Leitner Box method to test ourselves.

*All flashcards begin in Box 1. If you get one right, it moves to Box 2. If you get a Box 2 flashcard right, it moves to Box 3. If you get it wrong, it either moves down a box or stays in Box 1.*
